

Jan de Boer / **Hugo Meulenhof** died on the 18th of September, after suffering cardiac arrest. He was due to retire a day later. Hugo Meulenhof worked as one of the on-board deejays at Radio Mi Amigo in 1977. Later, he was briefly active in Flanders at Radio Gemini in Kortrijk. Since the start of 'Veronique' in 1989, he earned his living at RTL as an editor and 'voice over' for news coverage, a job he held for 34 years. He also worked weekends at RTL Rock in 1992.

On Radio Mi Amigo, he worked with Frank van der Mast, Herman de Graaf and Marc Jacobs, among others. Besides programmes like "Also Goeiemorgen", "Hallo bent U daar?" and the Top 40, Hugo was responsible, together with Frank, for the farewell programme on 23 July 1977, called "Farewell 1-9-2, all the best with it". A few days later, Radio Mi Amigo would return to the airwaves on 212 metres.
